- Provides an understanding of their responsibilities under fire safety legislation
- Classification of fire.
- Fire extinguisher training (Theory).
- Practical fire extinguisher training.
- Practical role of a fire warden explained.
- Human behaviour in fire.
- Company policies and procedures can be included.
- Smoke filled room scenario, when requested.
- Course duration 3 ½ hours / Maximum course size 15

Fire Awareness Residential Care Homes Course

- Passive and active fire precautions explained.
- Specialist evacuation procedures for the evacuation of residents.
- Ensures compliance with HTM 84 (Residential care premises guidance document)
